

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to www.burdhomehealth.com and Burd Home Health and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to Burd Home Health include www.burdhomehealth.com. The Burd Home Health website is a home health site. By using the Burd Home Health website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

Burd Home Health may collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your:

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Burd Home Health's public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others.

We do not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information to us when you elect to use certain products or services available on the Site. These may include: (a) registering for an account on our Site; (b) entering a sweepstakes or contest sponsored by us or one of our partners; (c) signing up for special offers from selected third parties; (d) sending us an email message; (e) submitting your credit card or other payment information when ordering and purchasing products and services on our Site. To wit, we will use your information for, but not limited to, communicating with you in relation to services and/or products you have requested from us. We also may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

Burd Home Health does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

Burd Home Health may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Burd Home Health, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Burd Home Health may disclose your personal information, without notice, if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Burd Home Health or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Burd Home Health; and/or (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Burd Home Health, or the public.

Tracking User Behavior

Burd Home Health may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within Burd Home Health, in order to determine what Burd Home Health services are the most popular. This data is

used to deliver customized content and advertising within Burd Home Health to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Burd Home Health. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Burd Home Health website.

Use of Cookies

The Burd Home Health website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Burd Home Health pages, or register with Burd Home Health site or services, a cookie helps Burd Home Health to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on.
